


Meditations on the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary


Apostles Creed

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord;


Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried.




For The Virtue of Faith:

The Agony in the Garden


We pray for


“My soul is



Hail Mary...




The high priest asked Pilate to condemn Jesus.




Our Savior was bound to a pillar.

Hail Mary...




Our Lord's sacred


Our Savior

The Third Sorrowful Mystery:


The Crowning with Thorns


“And the soldiers plaiting a crown of thorns, put it upon his head.”




The crowd still insisted that


Jesus

My Spirit.”



head and died.




Blood and


Mary received

promises of Christ.




Let us pray:
