Catholic Healthcare International (CHI) has been granted the singular blessing to replicate St. Padre Pio's model of healthcare delivery, *The Home for the Relief of Suffering*, in the US. On May 24, 2024, CHI signed a formal Purchase Agreement with Trinity Health to acquire its campus and hospital facility in Howell, Michigan. Closing is scheduled for the Summer of 2026, and this campus will be renovated to become the home for CHI's medical center and medical school, both in the charism of our Patron St. Padre Pio.

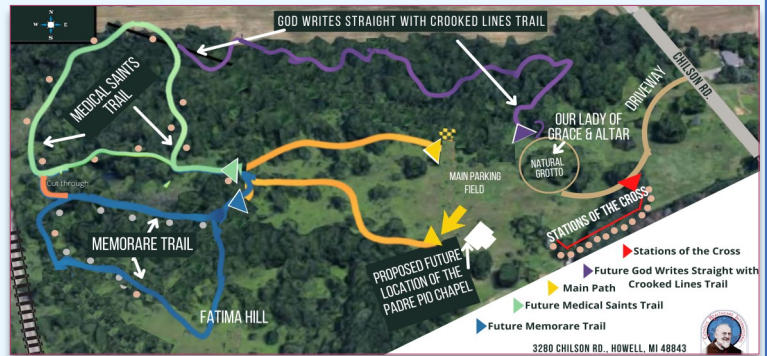

ST. PIO EUCHARISTIC ADORATION CHAPEL



\$5 Million is needed to build a replica of St. Pio's original friary Church in Italy, the **St. Pio Eucharistic Adoration Chapel** on the land donated by Bishop Boyea in Howell, MI. Your gift will serve generations!



Thanks to the generous donation of 40 acres of land by the Diocese of Lansing, we are developing the **Padre Pio Prayer Campus** as the foundation of prayer upholding all of our work. This peaceful and serenely inspirational campus features a beautiful **mural of Our Lady of Grace**, the **"Pray, Hope & Don't Worry" altar**, a life-size **bronze statue of Young Padre Pio**, and miles of themed trails through the woods including:

1. **The Stations of the Cross Trail** commissioned to American Artist Joseph Chovan and incorporating Padre Pio sharing in the passion of Jesus on His journey to Calvary;
2. **The Medical Saints Trail*** with beautiful original marble statues of saints who served their lives in a healthcare ministry;
3. **The Memorare Trail*** honoring Our Blessed Mother with a meditation of the beautiful "Memorare" prayer and culminating with a life-size marble statue set of Our Lady of Fatima and the shepherd children; and,
4. **The God Writes Straight with Crooked Lines Trail*** featuring the life stories of ordinary Catholics who persevered great struggles in life to become great saints.
